What are the final steps in the process? An appointment packet will be reviewed between NYSILC and ACCES-VR on September 20th. Following that meeting, the packet will be developed into a NYS Education Department Regents item. It will then be scheduled for action at an upcoming Regents meeting in mid-December 2016.
